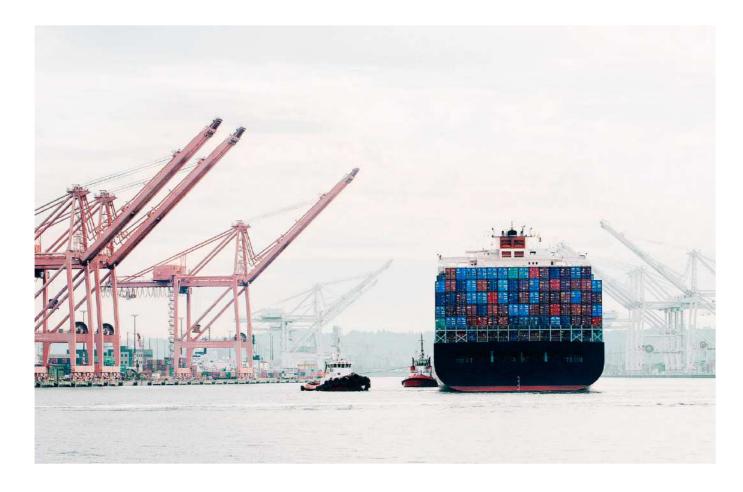

# Paris MoU Ship Risk Profile

## Brief description

The Paris MoU new inspection regime, which became effective as of 1 January 2011, is built on two fundamental principles:

- Ship Risk Profile (Low Standard High), and
- Company performance

The Ship Risk Profile is a useful indication for underwriters' risk assessment, but requires the use of a "ship risk profile calculator" and a "company performance calculator". Hence, it would be helpful if the information was integrated into Equasis under key indicators (ship info page).

Tokyo MoU announced in a press release 15 February 2013 that they would introduce a new inspection regime, building on the one from Paris MoU, as of 2014.
