Flat racks - Heavy-weight champions with a catch

Whenever it gets big and heavy in containerised transport, flat racks take the strain. With payloads of up to 50 mt, flat racks allow the shipment of liner cargo that will not fit into any container, and this is particularly favourable for today's just-in-time manufacturers. However, transport of large and heavy cargo is still risky business. Excessive width or height can damage the cargo even during transport or handling. Careful planning and regular inspections will minimise these risks.
