The Poseidon Principles for Marine Insurance (PPMI) are a global framework for assessing climate alignments of insurers' hull and machinery portfolios. The PPMI use the ambitions of the International Maritime Organization's (IMO) greenhouse gas emissions strategy and the Paris Agreement as benchmarks. The first annual disclosure report of the PPMI signatory companies has just been published.
