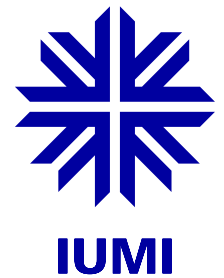


IUMI celebrates 140th anniversary with Hong Kong conference
