 - Education

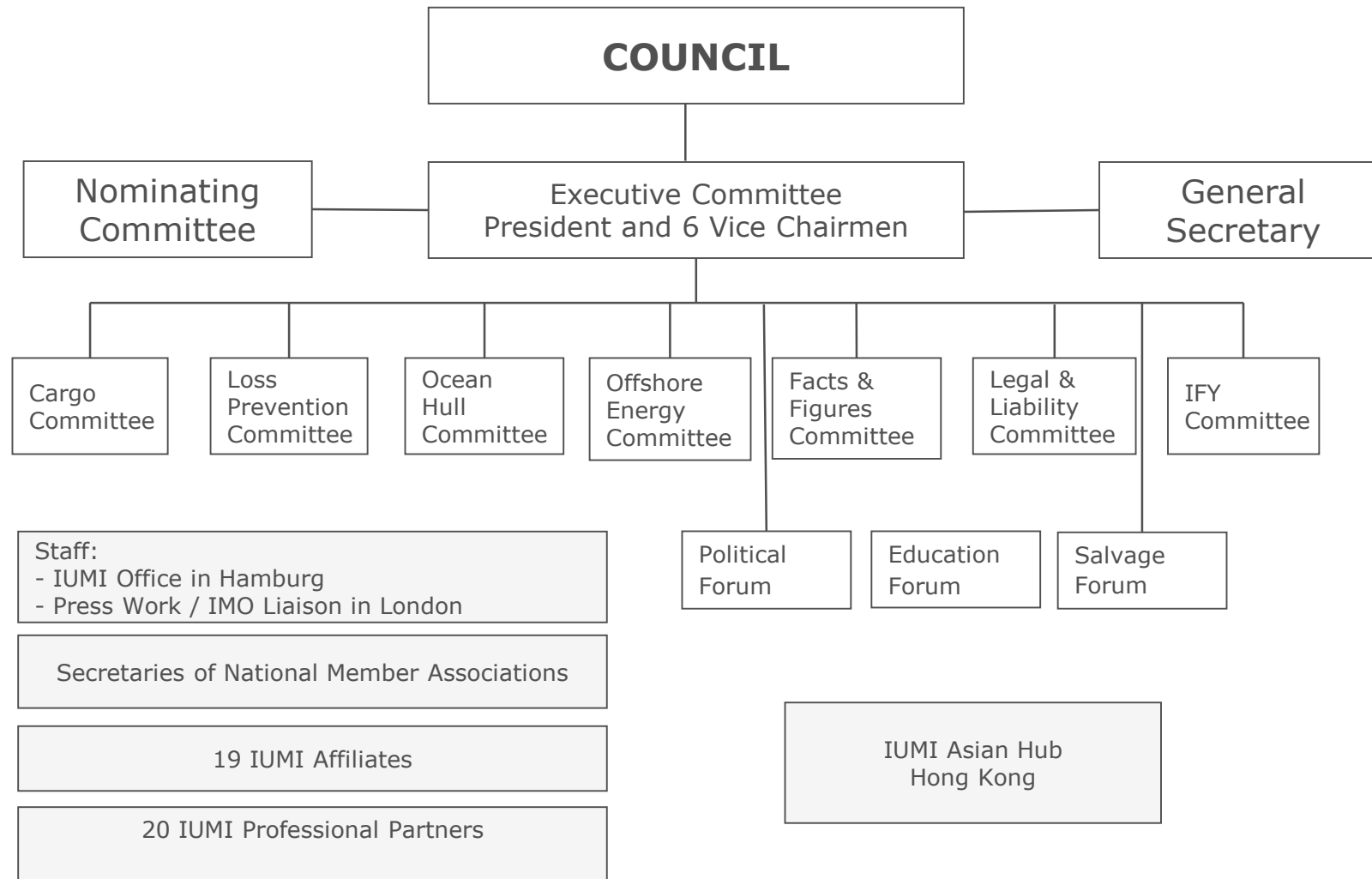

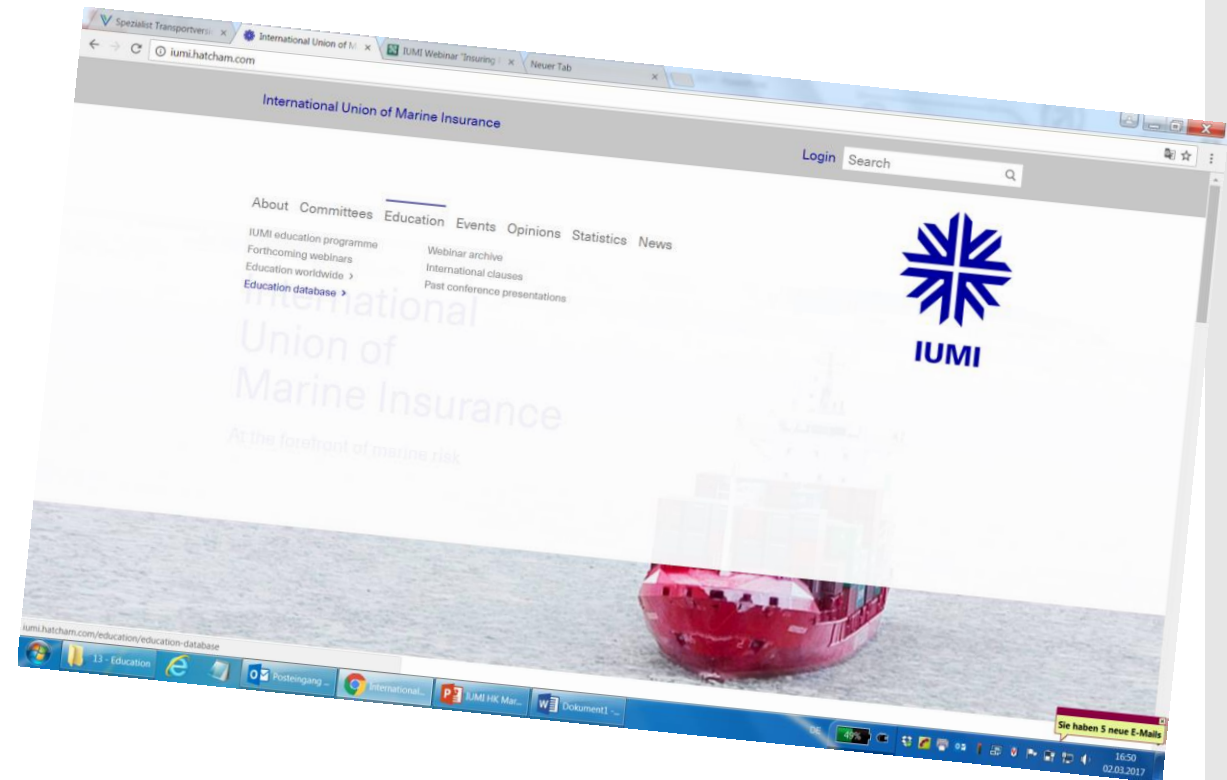

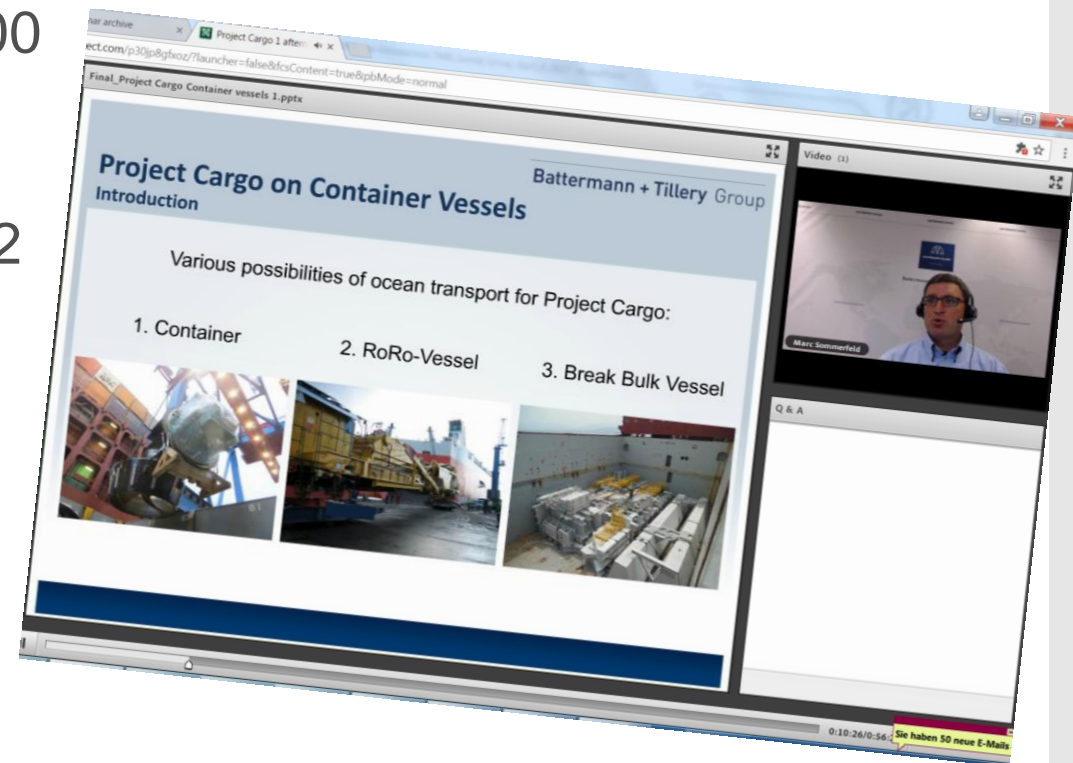


Progress & Status
