1. Minutes from meeting on the 15th April 2024

The minutes of the meeting held on the 15 April 2024 were agreed by all.

2. Facts and Figures Committee Updates Election/Re-election

JL – Updated the committee of the vacancies that are due to be filled after the Berlin conference. The committee were advised who would be stepping down namely Robert Copp, Stephan Klein, Kotaro Miyata and Xiaoxuan Li (Sherwin) and Erika Schoch. Committee members Emiel Paaij would renew their term for a further 3 years and Bruno Davila-Garcia would be replaced by Sebastian Kindlein.

This would then leave a total of 6 vacancies and 1 junior vacancy after Berlin.

3. Chair's Presentation (JL)

JL – Talked through his slides as he presented them to the committee. These had been sent to members in advance and Jun thanked everyone for their helpful comments.

JL – Noted that due to the timings for this year's slot we would not have time for questions after the presentation so will request that any questions from the audience are put forward to be replied to afterwards.

4. Global Marine Insurance Report Presentation (AS)

AS – Talked through her slides as she presented them to the committee. These had been sent to members in advance and Astrid thanked everyone for their helpful comments.

5. Major Claims Database Presentation (DM/BCG)

VH – Reintroduced himself and his new role explaining that he would be taking ownership of the Major Claims Database working closely with BCG. The plan was to arrange to meet with the associations in order to engage and explain how we need to receive the data, confirming the definition of the leader in order to reduce duplications.

There continued to be good support from associations in providing major loss data, with more countries joining this year. The cargo data was still ore reliable than hull, therefore it was agreed to include a few cargo slides within Jun's presentation.

6. Review 2024 Workshop

Moody's Presentation – This was yet to be received

Clarkson's Presentation – This was reviewed by the committee and agreed that the content covered everything required.

JL – Noted that he would check with Clarksons and S&P if the data provided for the spring meeting can be published on the IUMI website.

7. IUMI Business Analyst Development Idea (VH)

VH – Confirmed that he will be working closely with Astrid on the statistics as he will be producing the data for 2025.

Veith will be the primary contact to the commercial external data providers (Clarksons, LLI S&P) and will secure the half-yearly updates (spring states and information needed prior to the conference).

Veigh will also be the main link between the F&F committee and other IUMI Committees.

AS - Noted that Veith will see what work needs to be completed on the Hull and Cargo index and will follow up with Laurent in terms of data related to sustainability issues from the F&F perspective.

MC – Suggested one thing to discuss at the Spring meeting was if F&F could do real disaster scenarios for cruise vessels, tanker collisions as an example.

XL – Stated that Port Data would be interesting to have.
